April 19, 2022 Regular Town Board Meeting

The April Town Board meeting was held after the Annual meeting on April 19, 2022 at the Evergreen Town Hall, W8896 Carlton Rd, Spooner. The meeting was properly advertised and all interested parties were notified.

Those present were Tim Kessler, Gary Scalzo, Tim Wallace, Mary Zehm, Larry Bascombe, Brian & Mavis Melton, Tom Biver, Steve Sutter, Scott Corbin, Maria Busch, Virginia Elsen and Julie Kessler.

Motion by Scalzo, second by Wallace, to approve the agenda with the removal of #7 – Road Right-of-Way Clearing as it was handled at the annual meeting. Motion Carried

Motion by Wallace, second by Scalzo, to approve the minutes of the March 14, 2022 Regular Monthly meeting. Motion Carried

Clerk Kessler reported on the election, attended the County Municipal Clerk's meeting and Town's Association training. Motion by Scalzo, second by Wallace, to approve the Clerk's report. Motion Carried

Treasurer Zehm gave her monthly report and reported that she had sent out 12 dog license letters for those that had not renewed this year. Motion by Scalzo, second by Wallace, to approve the Treasurer's Report. Motion Carried

Larry Bascombe reported that besides the brushing, they have been patching and put a culvert in on Dock Lake Rd. The plows are taken off and equipment prepared for other work.

Chair Kessler reported that the township received a TRI-D grant of \$159,861.24 (50%) of the estimated cost for the Dock Lake Road project and was that we are the only township that received one in Washburn County. So far this year, project costs have increased 22-24%. Chair also reported that he will be applying for the BIL STP funding for 2 projects. These could be up to 90% funded if we are successful.

There was no correspondence.

Brian Melton thanked the Chair for going after the grant funding for the township. Steve Sutter thanked the crew for the patching and Virginia Elsen asked about town clean-up day.
