Larry Bascombe reported that they have plowed and sanded the roads and cleaned up after snow as needed. Chair Kessler reported on one citizen complaint that will be looked into.

Clerk Kessler reported that we received a donation for the cemetery from someone whos' parents are buried there. Chair Kessler responded to a question from last month with how the cemetery will be run since the transfer has been complete. He checked with the state and they responded that the board can choose to write an ordinance for operation. Motion by Wallace, second by Scalzo, to have the Clerk prepare an ordinance for next month for the board to operate the cemetery and the Clerk to be the Sexton. Motion Carried

The Clerk and the Chair have both searched for the ATV/UTV Ordinance that was passed in 2010 but haven't been able to locate it. Clerk Kessler will continue searching or draft new for the next meeting.

Chair Kessler reported that we still have a credit balance for LP to heat the hall.
